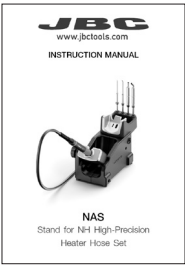

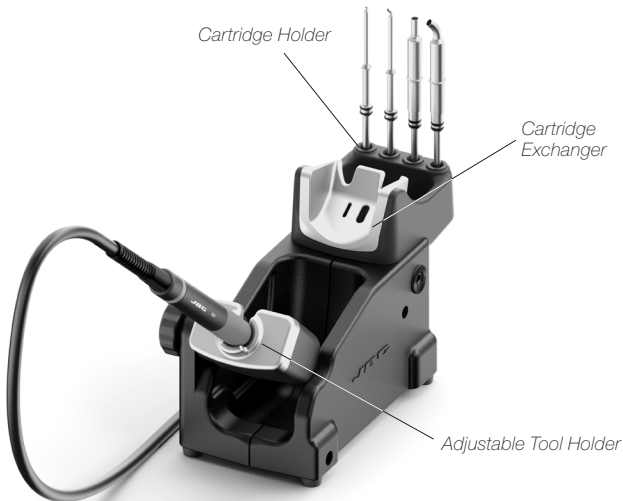

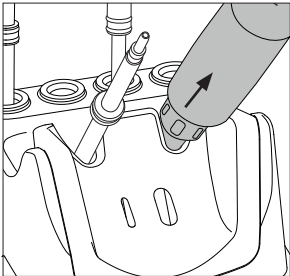

Changing Cartridges*

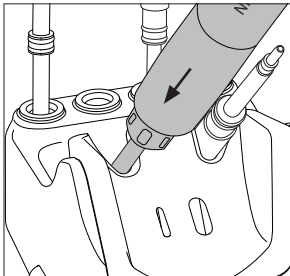
Save time and change the cartridge safely without switching the station off.

1. Removing



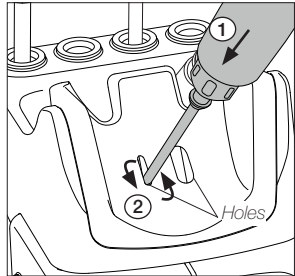
Place the cartridge in the extractor and pull the handle to remove it. Use the ring (J325) or umbrella (J125) around the cartridge as a stop to extract it from the tool.

2. Inserting



Place the handpiece on top of the new cartridge and press down slightly.

3. Fixing



Push against the holes to fix the cartridge (1). The extractor opening also allows correcting the nozzle angle of curved cartridges. To do this, rotate the tool (2) with the cartridge inserted in the extractor until the nozzle is in the proper position.

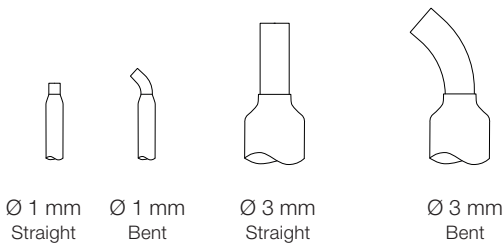
*Important

It is essential to insert the cartridge up to the mark for a proper connection.

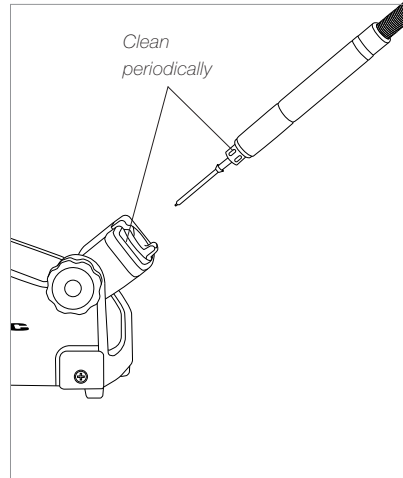

Maintenance

Before carrying out maintenance or storage, always unplug the stand from the station and the tool.

- Use a damp cloth to clean the stand. Alcohol can be used only when cleaning the metal parts.
- Check periodically that the metal parts of the tool/stand are clean so that the station can check the tool's status.
- Periodically check all cables and tube connections.
- Replace any defective or damaged parts. Use original JBC spare parts only.
- Repairs should only be performed by a JBC authorized technical service.



Safety



It is imperative to follow safety guidelines to prevent electric shock, injury, fire or explosion.

- Do not use the stands for any purpose other than soldering or rework.
- The power cord must be plugged into approved bases. Be sure that it is properly grounded before use. When unplugging it, hold the plug, not the wire.
- The tool should be placed in the stand when is not in use in order to activate the sleep mode. The soldering tip, the metal part of the tool and the stand may still be hot even when the station is turned off. Handle with care, including when adjusting the stand position.
- Avoid the contact of flux with skin or eyes to prevent irritation.
- Be careful with the fumes produced when soldering.
- Keep your workplace clean and tidy. Wear appropriate protection glasses and gloves when working to avoid personal harm.
- Utmost care must be taken with liquid tin waste which can cause burns.
- This appliance can be used by children over the age of eight and also persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience provided that they have been given adequate supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance and understand the hazards involved. Children must not play with the appliance.
- Maintenance must not be carried out by children unless supervised.
